**adb** - Apple Desktop Bus

**SYNOPSIS**

To compile this driver into the kernel, place the following lines in your kernel configuration file:

**device adb**

**DESCRIPTION**

The **adb** driver provides support for the Apple Desktop Bus, which is a simple multi-drop bus used in general for input peripherals in older Apple Macintosh hardware.

The Apple Desktop Bus provides attachment for up to 16 devices, including multiple devices of a single type, but not does support hot-plugging.
