**ARGUMENTS**

Gsasl \* ctx libgsasl handle.

const char \* mech  
name of SASL mechanism.

Gsasl\_session \*\* sctx  
pointer to server handle.

**DESCRIPTION**

This functions initiates a server SASL authentication. This function must be called before any other `gsasl_server_*()` function is called.

Return value: Returns **GSASL\_OK** if successful, or error code.
