

**NAME**

libssh2\_sftp\_shutdown - shut down an SFTP session

**SYNOPSIS**

```
#include <libssh2.h>
#include <libssh2_sftp.h>
```

```
int
libssh2_sftp_shutdown(LIBSSH2_SFTP *sftp);
```

**DESCRIPTION**

*sftp* - SFTP instance as returned by **libssh2\_sftp\_init(3)**

Destroys a previously initialized SFTP session and frees all resources associated with it.

**RETURN VALUE**

Return 0 on success or negative on failure. It returns LIBSSH2\_ERROR\_EAGAIN when it would otherwise block. While LIBSSH2\_ERROR\_EAGAIN is a negative number, it is not really a failure per se.
