marco-message - A command to send messages to Marco.

SYNOPSIS

marco-message [**OPTIONS**]

DESCRIPTION

The **marco-message** command is used to perform some simple window manager tasks while Marco is running.

OPTIONS**restart**

Restart a currently running instance of **marco**.

reload-theme

Reload the current window border theme specified in the dconf database.
(/org/mate/marco/general/theme)

enable-keybindings

Enable all keybindings specified in the dconf database. (/org/mate/marco/)

disable-keybindings

Disable all keybindings specified in the dconf database. (/org/mate/marco/)

toggle-verbose

Enable or Disable debugging messages for **marco**.
