mate-desktop-item-edit - A small tool to edit .desktop files.

**SYNOPSIS**

**mate-desktop-item-edit** [**OPTIONS**] [**FILE**]

**DESCRIPTION**

Distributed with mate-panel, **mate-desktop-item-edit** allows you to edit .desktop files.

**OPTIONS****--create-new**

Create a new file in the given directory.

**--display=DISPLAY**

X display to use.

**-, -h, --help**

Print standard command line options.

**--help-all**

Print all command line options.

This program also accepts the standard GTK options.

**EXAMPLES**

**mate-desktop-item-edit --create-new ~/Desktop/Icon.desktop**

Open a **mate-desktop-item-edit** dialog to create a launcher icon on the desktop named "Icon".
