`mysql_options` - Used to set extra connect options and affect behavior of a connection

Synopsis

```
#include <mysql.h>

int mysql_options(MYSQL * mysql,
                  enum mysql_option,
                  const void * arg);
```

Description

Used to set extra connect options and affect behavior for a connection. This function may be called multiple times to set several options. `mysql_options()` should be called after **`mysql_init(3)`**.

Notes

This function is deprecated, new implementations should use **`mysql_optionsv(3)`** api function instead.
