Positions the row cursor to an arbitrary row in a result set which was obtained by **mysql_stmt_store_result(3)**.

Parameter

- stmt a statement handle, which was previously allocated by mysql_stmt_init(3).
- offset row offset. This value can be obtained either by mysql_stmt_row_seek() or
 mysql_stmt_row_tell(3).

Return value

Returns the previous row offset.

Notes

The result set must be obtained by **mysql_use_result(3)**.
