mysql_stmt_row_seek - Positions row cursor.

Synopsis

MYSQL_ROW_OFFSET mysql_stmt_row_seek(MYSQL_STMT * stmt,  
                                     MYSQL_ROW_OFFSET offset);
```

Description

Positions the row cursor to an arbitrary row in a result set which was obtained by **mysql_stmt_store_result(3)**.

Parameter

- ⊕ stmt - a statement handle, which was previously allocated by **mysql_stmt_init(3)**.
- ⊕ offset - row offset. This value can be obtained either by **mysql_stmt_row_seek()** or **mysql_stmt_row_tell(3)**.

Return value

Returns the previous row offset.

Notes

The result set must be obtained by **mysql_use_result(3)**.
