php-config - get information about PHP configuration and compile options

**SYNOPSIS**

**php-config** [options]

**DESCRIPTION**

**php-config** is a simple shell script for obtaining information about installed PHP configuration.

**OPTIONS**

<b>--prefix</b>	Directory prefix where PHP is installed, e.g. /usr/local
<b>--includes</b>	List of -I options with all include files
<b>--ldflags</b>	LD Flags which PHP was compiled with
<b>--libs</b>	Extra libraries which PHP was compiled with
<b>--man-dir</b>	The directory prefix where the manpages is installed
<b>--extension-dir</b>	Directory where extensions are searched by default
<b>--include-dir</b>	Directory prefix where header files are installed by default
<b>--php-binary</b>	Full path to php CLI or CGI binary
<b>--php-sapis</b>	Show all SAPI modules available
<b>--configure-options</b>	Configure options to recreate configuration of current PHP installation
<b>--version</b>	PHP version
<b>--vernum</b>	PHP version as integer
