

**NAME**

**unvis** - revert a visual representation of data back to original form

**SYNOPSIS**

**unvis** [-e] [-Hh | -m] [*file* ...]

**DESCRIPTION**

**unvis** is the inverse function of **vis**(1). It reverts a visual representation of data back to its original form on standard output.

The options are as follows:

- e** Don't decode \ escaped sequences.
- H** Decode entity references and numeric character references from RFC 1866. (VIS\_HTTP1866)
- h** Decode using the URI encoding from RFC 1808. (VIS\_HTTP1808)
- m** Decode using mime style. (VIS\_MIMESTYLE)

Mixing **-h** or **-H** with **-m** is not supported.
