unvis - revert a visual representation of data back to original form

SYNOPSIS

```
unvis [-e] [-Hh | -m] [file ...]
```

DESCRIPTION

unvis is the inverse function of vis(1). It reverts a visual representation of data back to its original form on standard output.

The options are as follows:

- **-e** Don't decode \ escaped sequences.
- **-H** Decode entity references and numeric character references from RFC 1866. (VIS_HTTP1866)
- -h Decode using the URI encoding from RFC 1808. (VIS_HTTP1808)
- -m Decode using mime style. (VIS_MIMESTYLE)

Mixing -h or -H with -m is not supported.
