

**NAME**

**valloc** - aligned memory allocation function

**LIBRARY**

Standard C Library (libc, -lc)

**SYNOPSIS**

```
#include <unistd.h>
```

```
void *
valloc(size_t size);
```

**DESCRIPTION**

The **valloc()** function is obsoleted by **posix\_memalign(3)**, which can be used to request page-aligned allocations.

The **valloc()** function allocates *size* bytes aligned on a page boundary.

**RETURN VALUES**

The **valloc()** function returns a pointer to the allocated space if successful; otherwise a null pointer is returned.

The **valloc()** function appeared in 3.0BSD.

The **valloc()** function correctly allocated memory that could be deallocated via **free()** starting in FreeBSD 7.0.
