## REPLY FIELDS

*sequence*        The sequence number of the last request processed by the X11 server.

*length*           The length of the reply, in words (a word is 4 bytes).

### RETURN VALUE

Returns an *xcb\_x\_print\_print\_get\_one\_attributes\_cookie\_t*. Errors have to be handled when calling the reply function *xcb\_x\_print\_print\_get\_one\_attributes\_reply*.

If you want to handle errors in the event loop instead, use  
*xcb\_x\_print\_print\_get\_one\_attributes\_unchecked*. See **xcb-requests(3)** for details.
